I have lived in Penge for 43 years. Before that I gained BA and D Phil degrees in Chemistry at Oxford University, and conducted research in Protein Chemistry in Cambridge, London and Berlin before working at Wellcome Research Laboratories in Beckenham for 17 years. A universal basic income combined with a wealth tax on the top 1% would improve life for all. We must accept that frequent flying must be stopped. At the same time we must invest in the real green economy for a sustainable future.

I am a member of CND, The National Trust, Humanists UK and The Allotments Association, and a supporter of Make Votes Matter. I was formerly Secretary of Upper Chesham Allotments, and still cultivate my plot. I applaud those who volunteer to keep our parks clean and attractive. I oppose the use of plastic packaging.
